2010 EASTER ORCHID SHOW

Good Friday 2nd & Easter Saturday 3rd April 2010

It is that time of year again when we stage our Easter Orchid Show at the Student Centre, Bribie Island State High School, First Avenue, Bribie Island. This is an orchid and plant show which is an opportunity for collectors and gardeners to see and purchase varieties of plants including the release of the special Dtps Bribie Q150 orchid which was developed last year to commemorate Queensland's 150th Anniversary. Set-up time for benching of orchids and Floral Art is from 5.00pm to 7.00pm on Thursday 1st April.

The Show will be open to the public on Good Friday 2nd April from 9.00am to 4.00pm and Easter Saturday 3rd April 2009 from 9.00am to 2.30pm with Presentation of Awards at 2.30pm on Saturday. Entry to the show is \$4.00 per person with Morning/Afternoon Tea included. If you wish to organize a bus trip, we have a reduced entry price of \$3.50 per person for groups of 10 or more and again, Morning/Afternoon Tea is included. We can also assist you will planning a day out here on our beautiful island home.

Visitors are given the opportunity to come and talk to the people who grow the plants as well as to sit back and enjoy the beautiful, fragrant display. Orchid sales, fertilisers, pots etc, African Violets, Clivias, Bromeliads, Carnivorous Plants, Floral Art, light refreshments and much more are available so you can see why our shows are so popular with both the local and wider community. There are various nurseries selling plants along with our Craft and Cake stall where you can purchase some home-made 'goodies' which might be useful with Mother's Day just around the corner.

We also invite members of Floral Art Societies to exhibit in the Floral Art Section. While there is only one class, we feel this show gives folk the opportunity to share their love of Floral Art with the community as well as the enjoyment and experience of benching an arrangement. It also gives societies exposure to our visitors and may help increase their membership numbers. Here are the details of the Classes.

Class 11 - Floral Art Competition - Open Class

Class 11.01 An Easter Arrangement – "He Is Risen" Any orchids/flowers may be used.

Class 11.02 A Foliage Arrangement in Autumn Tones

Rules & Conditions:

Classes will be judged on colour, harmony, relationship between plant material and container, design, distinction or originality, condition of plant material and interpretation of theme. Accessories are permitted in all arrangements.

Setting up is from 4.00pm to 5.00pm on Thursday 1st April and judging commences at 7.00pm.

Arrangements must not be removed from display until after Presentation of Awards.
